Information on Membership Classes

Membership runs 1st November to 31st October, no reductions are made for joining part way through a year.

Voluntary and Community FULL Membership (complete Parts One & Two) - Cost £55

Full Members receive the full information service including exclusive access to the member's e-group, discounted Regional Forum event fee and also a vote at the Forum AGM. This membership class is open to voluntary and community organisations providing a service within Yorkshire and the Humber and falling into one or more of the following categories:

- *Regional voluntary or community organisations.*
- *Voluntary or community agencies providing an umbrella or intermediary role and providing support to other voluntary or community organisations.*
- *Voluntary or community organisations providing services to other voluntary agencies over the region, county or district.*
- *Regional branches of national voluntary or community organisations*
- *Federations or groups of voluntary or community organisations*
- *Local voluntary organisations playing a key role in co-ordination between voluntary/community organisations.*

Full members should complete Parts One and Two of the application form to help keep the Regional Forum up to date with member's details. Full members are asked to circulate relevant information sent out by the Regional Forum to their members / sub-branches / service users.

Voluntary and Community Sector ASSOCIATE Membership (complete Part One only) – Cost £55

Open to **all** other voluntary and/or community groups. Associate Members receive the full information service, discounted Regional Forum event fee and are invited to the AGM but have no voting rights.

Other Associate Memberships (complete Part One only) - Cost £110

Other Associate Members receive the full information service, discounted Regional Forum event fee and are invited to the AGM but have no voting rights. This membership is open to non-voluntary / community sector organisations who are actively supporting voluntary / community sector groups and activity, for example:

- Statutory Departments (County, District or Local) working with or supporting Community/Voluntary Organisations or Local Authority hosted partnerships;
- Consultants or Businesses working with or supporting Community/Voluntary Groups;
- Individual persons, societies, companies, associations, local authorities and other bodies which support the objects of the Forum.

Bursary Scheme – Cost £15
