BY CAR

From North

From M62, join M621 towards Leeds.

Come off at Junction 3, sign posted City Centre.

Follow signs to City Centre on to Neville Street, passing the Hilton Hotel on the left.

Keep in right hand lane under Railway Bridge, into Bishopgate.

Keep right, where road forks in City Square, following loop traffic on to Quebec Street.

Place yourself in left hand lane on Quebec Street.

At next set of traffic lights turn right on to East Parade, keep in left hand lane.

At following set of traffic lights, turn left on to The Headrow.

Keep in right lane through 4 sets of traffic lights.

After fourth set, filter off and turn right between Park Lane College and Concord House

Take immediate right again to the entrance of Joseph's Well.

From South (M1)

Follow M1 North until it splits into M1 and M621.

Take M621 North and come off at Junction 3, sign posted City Centre.

Follow signs to City Centre on to Neville Street, passing the Hilton Hotel on the left.

Keep in right hand lane under Railway Bridge, into Bishopgate.

Keep right, where road forks in City Square, following loop traffic on to Quebec Street.

Place yourself in left hand lane on Quebec Street.

At next set of traffic lights turn right on to East Parade, keep in left hand lane.

At following set of traffic lights, turn left on to The Headrow.

Keep in right lane through 4 sets of traffic lights.

After fourth set, filter off and turn right between Park Lane College and Concord House.

Take immediate right again to the entrance of Joseph's Well.

Parking

There is limited parking available at Joseph's Well. Please inform us beforehand if you require a car parking space so we can obtain a pass for you. Visitor parking is limited to 2 hours. For the nearest car park please see Leeds City Council's website:

BY RAIL

The office is approximately 10-15 minutes walk from Leeds Train Station. For train timetables see Trainline's website: <http://www.thetrainline.com/>. The 18 / 18A bus can be taken from the station to Burley Road. Alight opposite Park Lane College.

BY TAXI

There is a taxi rank outside Leeds Railway Station, Joseph's Well is approximately a 5 minute drive and should cost you in the region of £3.

BY BUS

For bus times see the journey planner section on the Metro website <http://www.wymetro.com>

The bus journey is approximately 5 minutes. Alight opposite the Park Lane College.

Number 50: From the Headrow (opposite the Henry Moore Art Gallery) to Park Lane.

Number 54: From Infirmary Street (stop G) to Park Lane.

Number 18 / 18A: From the train station or Infirmary Street (stop G) to Park Lane.

FREE CITY BUS – There is a free City Bus which leaves Leeds Train Station every few minutes and travels around the loop road. Please visit www.wymetro.com for a map of the journey. You will need to alight at Stop 5 just outside Park Lane College.

ONCE IN THE BUILDING

IF you enter the building via the 'Main Entrance' which is manned by a commissionaire, and is near the Joseph's Well Pub, access to the Regional Forum is via the stairs, or the lift (this is on the 2nd floor) to floor D. On floor D follow signs to D10.

IF you enter the main car park using the security gate, do not enter the building via the door nearest to the commissionaires hut but continue past this and enter the next entrance door on your left in the corner of the building (do not enter the door that says Goods Entrance which is past this). From here take the stairs to floor D, turn left through the double doors - Regional Forum D10 is the 2nd door on the left. Or take the lift to floor D (this lift has pictures of canals and rivers in Leeds) when you exit the lift at floor D (the carpet is green and the wallpaper stripey) turn left through double doors, then turn left again and go through two sets of double doors, Regional Forum D10 is the 2nd door on the left. .
